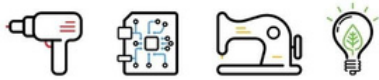

Makerspace Adelaide is looking for someone with a background in law. Ideally you will have experience in commercial property, corporate governance or HR. A practicing lawyer is preferred.

### WHAT YOU ARE COMMITTING TO

Makerspace Adelaide is looking for someone to provide broad-strokes legal advice on issues pertaining to the running of Makerspace Adelaide.

This would be up to a couple of hours a month fielding questions from the Operations Manager, via phone or email.
